

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

When is the event?

Sunday 12 March 2017

What time does the event start?

10km run or walk: 10.00am

5km run or walk: 10.15am

3km run or walk: 10.15am

Where does the event start and finish?

10km run or walk: Start at Forsyth Barr Stadium and finish at Hancock Park.

5km run or walk: Start and finish at Hancock Park.

3km run or walk: Start and finish at Hancock Park.

What is the cost of the event?

10km run or walk: \$25.00

5km run or walk: \$10.00

3km run or walk (great option for the kids): \$5.00

What if I don't have a credit or debit card?

We can accept cash payment registrations, (no eftpos available) at Sport Otago. You can find us at the Sargood Centre, 40 Logan Park Drive, Dunedin. Reception is open between 8.30am-5.00pm, Monday to Friday.

When do online entries close?

Friday 10 March 2017 at 5.00pm.

Can I register on the day?

You can register on the day with cash payments only. Please allow plenty of time before the event starts.

On the day registration price:

10km run or walk: \$35.00

5km run or walk: \$20.00

3km run or walk: \$10.00

Where do I get my race pack from?

Race pack pick-up is available on Friday 10 March 2017 from 6.00pm-8.00pm and Saturday 11 March from 9.00am-11.00am. The venue for these options is the Sargood Centre Gallery, Logan Park Drive, Dunedin.

Will I get my time at the end of the race?

You will not be individually given a time in this race; however a clock will be placed at the finish line for self-timing. This event is a fun run and walk, and the challenge is completing the course. You are welcome to time yourself using your own device.

Course Information

Is the course accessible for wheelchairs?

Wheelchair users are welcome to take part in this event, however we advise you to check the suitability of the course and decide whether this will work for you. The 10km event goes across sports fields and the 3km and 5km events are based on sports fields.

Is the course open to scooters, skateboards, bikes, roller-blades, prams, and buggies?

For Health and Safety reasons, please don't bring scooters, skateboards, roller-blades or bikes. As this is a family friendly event, you are welcome to take part with buggies and prams.

Can I bring my dog?

Guide-dogs are welcome on the race track for those who require them.

Are drink stations available on the course?

There will be a drink station at the Harbour Mouth Molars on Portsmouth Drive and again at the finish line at Hancock Park.

Are toilets available on the course?

There are toilets available at the start and finish line. There is a public toilet in Wharf Street and at Bayfield Park.

Will the course be closed to traffic?

All roads are open to traffic, therefore please obey the traffic rules at all times. Traffic Management Officials will be placed on the course.

Has the course been officially measured?

The course hasn't been measured for official purposes. You are welcome to use your own device to measure your personal distance travelled.

Transport

Where can I park my vehicle?

For 10km entrants, there is a range of parking options at the Logan Park area and limited parking at Forsyth Barr Stadium.

For 3km and 5km entrants, parking is available at the Dunedin Ice Stadium and along Victoria Road.

Are buses provided to get back to Forsyth Barr Stadium?

Buses will be running return trips from St Clair to Forsyth Barr Stadium. This service is included in the entry fee. Buses will leave from Victoria Road, beside Hancock Park, near the intersection at John Wilson Ocean Drive.

Race Day Information

Can I pick up my race pack on the day?

We encourage you to pick up your race pack on Friday or Saturday before the event. If you are unable to pick up your race pack beforehand, we will have it ready for you on race day in the start area. Please allow plenty of time to collect this before your race starts.

Are first-aid stations located on the course?

There are first-aid stations at the finish line. Please alert a race marshal if you need medical assistance.

Where can I leave my warm clothes for the finish?

For 10km entrants, you are welcome to leave gear in our gear-truck during the race. Your bag will be transported to Hancock Park, beside the Pirates Rugby Club Rooms.

For 3km and 5km entrants, an area for gear will be set up at Hancock Park.

Do I wear my race number on the back or front?

Please wear your number on the front of your running top and make sure it is visible at all times.

Can I listen to a music device during the event?

For Health and Safety reasons, headphones and personal music devices are discouraged.

What facilities are at the finish line?

We are planning a family friendly event area, offering a complete post-race experience with kids' entertainment, a sausage sizzle, and hot drinks. There will be free water, a first-aid station, and toilets available.

Where and when will spot prizes be drawn?

A whiteboard displayed at the finish area will list the names of those who have won spot prizes. You need to check whether your name is on the list and then pick up your prize from the information desk at the finish line. Those who register online are eligible for the major spot prizes that are drawn at the conclusion of the event. To win you need to be present to claim your prize that will be drawn at approximately 11.00am.
